# BOLD SARDINES PACKED TIGHT APP PLATE



## MATERIALS

DB37469 Sqrve Dessert Plate  
Medium Brush  
Detail Brush  
Liner Brush  
NCR Patterns  
Red Ballpoint Pen  
Pencil or Waterbased Marker  
Scissors

## COLORS

CMM 19 - Banana Boat  
CMM 18 - Pumpkin Pie  
CMM 7 - Blush  
CMM 47 - Deep Sea  
CMM 90 - Red Hot  
CMM 67 - Snowflake  
CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon  
CMM 55 - Sea Mist  
CMM 43 - Saffire

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. First, use a pencil or water-based marker to draw a soft rectangle on the top of the plate. Use the edge of the plate as a guide, and draw the line about 1/4" in from the edge.
2. Use a medium brush to apply three coats of Banana Boat inside the rectangle.
3. Next, use a liner brush to apply a thin line of Sea Mist around the yellow rectangle. After the first coat, apply a second coat.
4. Use scissors to cut the NCR paper pattern down so it's easier to transfer onto the piece.
5. Place the NCR paper pattern on the top of the plate, and firmly trace over the lines using a ballpoint pen.
6. Use a liner brush to fill in the fish with three coats of paint:
  - a. Top of the fish - Blush
  - b. Bottom of the fish - Pumpkin Pie
  - c. Face, tail, and fin of the fish - Red Hot
  - d. Side fin of the fish - Deep Sea
7. Fill in the pull tab pattern with three coats of Deep Sea on the inside, and Blue Lagoon for the outline. Consult the photo if that helps.
8. Using the photo as a guide, use a liner brush to apply a thin broken line of Pumpkin Pie around the fish. Repeat for a second coat.
9. Next, apply the words using a detail brush and two coats of Saffire.
10. Finally, dip the handle of the detail brush into Snowflake and tap a dot on each fish for the eye. Then dip the handle into Deep Sea and put a smaller dot inside each white dot.

## TIPS

- Apply three generous coats of paint in order to get solid colors.
- When using the liner brush, you can thin down the paint slightly to help the lines flow more easily.
